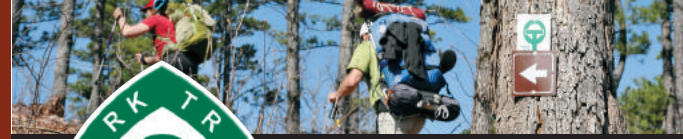


# EXPERIENCE MISSOURI'S WILDER SIDE

Choose a time and place that works for you and join us. Our **Adopt-A-Trail Program** helps keep the trail clear. Certified sawyers use chainsaws to keep the trail corridor open. Volunteers manage our events, coordinate trail planning and promote the Ozark Trail. There's something for everyone.

OTA volunteers have been recognized with U.S. Forest Service Volunteer Program awards and the trail was named a National Recreation Trail in 2008. Missouri was designated Best Trails State at the 2013 International Trails Symposium, thanks in part to Ozark Trail Association volunteers.

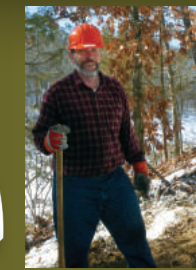
## Reap the Benefits.
